

Foel Friog Livery – Service Definition & Price List (as at August 2019)

Grass Livery *(seasonal availability)*

Provision of a grazing paddock only, for the horse(s).

All care, wellbeing & daily attention is the responsibility of the horse owner. Horses must be regularly wormed and in good health.

(Daily checks by the proprietor are an optional extra).

Price *by arrangement* (guide price £5/night or £15/week)

Basic DIY

Provision of a stable for the horse

Provision of an individual paddock when weather / ground conditions permit during the grass growing season (as a guide: usually April to early November)

Use of facilities as may be made available (currently: arena, round pen, stocks & weigh bridge, trailer parking)

Discretionary use of solarium (extra charges will apply for heavy usage)

Horse owner is responsible for carrying out all feeding, watering, mucking out, exercise, poo picking, turning in & out, etc. The proprietor may occasionally agree to place prepared feed in to stables as a favour.

Conserved forage / bedding are not included.

Price £25 / week or £100 / month

Assisted Livery (Winter)

Available by agreement, for the busy owner (so that only 1 visit/ day is required) As for Basic DIY but proprietor will also share the daily routine duties according to an individually tailored agreement.

Example Proprietor Routine:

Morning visual check

Evening Rounds: Bring in from Yard, Rug change, general check

Evening Feed: Feed pre-prepared ration

Night Rounds: visual check between 9pm – 10pm

Prices start at £60 / week or £240 / month

Full retirement Livery

Your horse will be fully cared for and pampered. All forage & bedding costs are included. If requested, you will be emailed once a week / monthly with a picture & short update.

Veterinary & Farrier fees are not included.

General Payment Terms

All livery to be paid 1 month in advance.

Termination of contract will require 1 month notice by either party.

All payments to be up to date before a horse leaves.
